Local teams around the world organise events on the third Saturday in September. In 2009, Software Freedom Day will be on September 19th.

In 2007 and 2008, the TTCS held SFD events and submitted reports to the Software Freedom Day organisation ; our reports for [2007](#) and [2008](#) both received "**highly commended**" awards from the Software Freedom Day organisation.

Venue for Trinidad : Long Circular Mall (available Sept 12th)

A booth/table would have a computer or two at a table to demonstrate some aspect of open source. Min 3 tables but cater for up to 5 tables

Outcome from Aug 19th, 2009 meeting - reduce tables to minimise number of people needed to cover outreach. Reduce to 2 tables to have 6 persons minimum needed for outreach
